#### INSTRUCTIONS FOR ABSTRACTPREPARATION

Abstracts must be written in English, using MS Word, and sent as an attachment by e-mail to the correspondence address, before May  $15^{th}$ , 2008.

The abstracts form (1 page) should be as follows:

Arial, single-spaced, right, left, top, and bottom margins should be all 3 cm. The following format should be kept:

- 1. Title, 14 pt., bold, all capital letters; centered
- 2. Author(s) name(s), presenting author's name underlined; centered
- 3. Affiliation of authors indicated by superscript numbers with addresses, fax numbers, e-mail, 12 pt.; centered
- 4. After a blank line, text should follows, 12 pt.
- 5. Acknowledgement line(s) if required, 11 pt.
- 6. After a blank line, References, e.g. [1] family name(s), initials, *journal*, volume, page (year).
