

for Young Researchers

Objectives:	The Medical University of Graz is an internationally oriented university where excellent biomedical research is conducted. In recognition of the fact that researchers' mobility, and especially the mobility of young researchers, is a key factor for the future competitiveness of European research and for the advancement of the medical sciences for the benefit of humankind, the Medical University of Graz invites one young researcher from abroad to carry out a project in collaboration with an Institute and/or Department of the Medical University in Graz.
Eligibility:	Applicants must be young researchers aged 35 or younger (cut-off date = submission deadline). Exceptions are possible for the field of Nursing Science.
Fields:	Nursing Science – Paediatrics – Cardiological Anesthesiology – Social Medicine – Endrocrinology – Experimental Neurotraumatology (Stem Cell Transplantation Following Brain Injury) – Dental Prosthetics – Experimental Neurogastroenterology (Behavioral and Neurochemical Studies in Response to Abdominal Immune Stress)
Duration:	approx. 7-8 months (The grant amounts to EUR 10.000 and covers travel costs as well as accommodation and subsistence in Graz.)
Requirements:	Candidates must have finished a PhD or equivalent doctoral program.
Application Documents:	 □ application form (http://www.meduni-graz.at/2555) □ description of the research to be conducted in Graz (including research objectives, methodology, work plan and calculation of costs) □ letter of motivation □ letter of recommendation □ curriculum vitae □ diplomas of post-secondary education and PhD certificate (or equivalent) □ description of previous research, especially in the field applied for □ publications in the field applied for (if available)
Submission Deadline:	15 January 2009 (postmark). Applications must be submitted both in print <u>and</u> per e-mail (see addresses below).
Evaluation:	All applications will be evaluated according to criteria of scientific quality by the University's Research Promotion Committee.
