The Johannes Kepler University Linz (Austria) is establishing a Ph.D. programme in “Molecular bioanalytics – from molecular recognition to membrane transport” funded by the Austrian Science Fund (FWF). It offers interdisciplinary research and training in Biophysics, Analytical Chemistry, Applied Physics, Bioorganic Chemistry, Molecular Biology, Molecular Pharmacology as well as Computational and Applied Mathematics. Its scientific goal is to gain insight into the molecular picture (1) of how molecules are recognised on the membrane surface and (2) of how they are conveyed through membrane proteins.
