



APPLICATION NOTICE AND GUIDE

The Medical School of the University of Pécs and the Faculty of Pharmacy are calling for applications for participating in the Erasmus+ Student Mobility for Studies in the Academic Year 2021/22

The aim of scholarship:

Funded by the European Union with the goal of improving academic, language and cultural experiences in another program country's higher educational institute for those students who have already obtained a high school diploma and are currently attending a higher education institution. The aim of study visit is to take part in a part-time study or write a thesis. The mobility can be realized in only those cases if the sending institution accepts the students' foreign studies and counts them in their studies. Rotational year students in General Medicine Major should do their practices taking into account the syllabi of the rotational year courses. They also have to do the relevant examination(s) at UP MS to get credits accepted. The minimum stay of foreign study is 3 months (90 days).

Students who fulfil their studies abroad in the framework of the Erasmus+ Program:

- spend 3-5 months (students in their 6th year) /5 or 10 months (students in their 5th year)* abroad depending on study year/partner university;
- must be enrolled at the University of Pécs Medical School or Faculty of Pharmacy, for the period spent at the receiving university;
- during their studies abroad, students should complete as many courses as it is required at UP MS/FPh to finish a semester/academic year. (Language courses and the Erasmus Intensive Language Course started before the semester do not count).
- applicants need to pay the normal tuition fee here in Pécs. At the receiving institution there is no tuition fee (though, there might be registration fee at some receiving universities);
- applicants should be Hungarian citizens, or students studying at a degree-seeking program of the University of Pécs Medical School or Faculty of Pharmacy;
- applicants need to comply with the application requirements;
- students with Stipendium Hungaricum scholarship cannot apply for Erasmus+ grant



- students can apply to more universities by ranking the places;
- PhD students may also carry out research activities specified in their training plan at the partner university as part-time training.
- successful applicants must take the on-line language test OLS (*Online Linguistic Support*) if the medium of instruction is not their mother tongue but one of the following: English, German, Italian, Spanish, French, or Dutch (more detailed information after the favourable evaluation of the application).

According to the rules/regulations of the Erasmus+ Programme each student can obtain Erasmus status for a maximum of 12 months per training level (study abroad and internship in total), thus if the student has already participated in Erasmus study abroad and/or internship, even if as a zero grant (LABEL) student, but has not used up the 12-month Erasmus period, he/she can apply again.

Students pursuing master level or doctoral studies who already were Erasmus students at their former training level(s) can also apply.

Students in the final year of their bachelor or master level studies who want to continue their studies should hand in their applications in September in the first semester of their master or doctoral studies.

The amount of the grant depends on the length of the study period (number of days) and on the host country. The following amounts of grant may presumably be awarded for the academic year 2021/2022 (1 month of mobility means 30 days).

All applicants are reminded that the grant will not fully cover the cost and expenses of the travel and the stay abroad, therefore additional sources are needed. Successful applicants may have to contribute to these costs and expenses from their own sources in addition to any support the faculty might award.



Process of Academic Scholarship:

1. Students need to have a written anticipatory permission from a tutor to complete the course.
2. Scholarship may last max. 5 months (6th year students at partner universities), or 5-10 months (5th year students)* depending on which year you are in.
3. Besides good scholastic record, B2 level language knowledge is also a must. If you win a place, you must take part in a language course or prove your knowledge at an exam. In case of Italy, Spain and France the host countries' language knowledge is compulsory.
4. Those who apply for a German speaking area have to take part in a language exam (oral) organized by the faculty Erasmus Office, this is an important condition of the application for German or Austrian Erasmus places.
5. Preference will be given to students who carry out research or do significant volunteering activity. [Evaluation criteria](#) can be downloaded from our website.
6. Students must carry out their mobility activity in a Programme Country different from the country of the sending organisation or country of residence.

Deadline and procedure of submitting the application:

1. Please submit the Application form and materials to **Ms. Anett Tomózer, Faculty Erasmus Coordinator** at the Office for International Relations and Erasmus Programme **exclusively in email** to erasmusoffice@aok.pte.hu by 4 March 2021! The **Application form** must be submitted **in Microsoft word format, typewritten**. Regarding other attachments, please pay attention to the **size of documents** enclosed and convert them to the smallest possible. **We accept documents attached only with the following form/title:** type of document_name of the applicant_location of the exchange program (e.g. Certificate of Demonstrator Student Activity_Sample James_Coimbra).
2. You also have to **apply online** at <https://outgoing.pte.hu/> to submit your application.

Application material submitted to our office should include the Application form (downloadable from our website) and the following documents:

- a copy of any **official language** certificates – (a high school certificate is not an official language certificate)
- **professional CV** (English or German language, depending on the host institutions(s))
- **certificate(s) of scientific and research activities** (please include the number of semesters you have spent performing the activity). Templates for certificates can be downloaded from our website!



- **certificate(s) of volunteering activities** (please include the number of events and the exact time spent (hours) on them). Templates for certificates can be downloaded from our website!
- ✓ The weighted academic average and corrected credit index of your last 3 semesters will be requested from the Registrar's Office **by our Office**.

We cannot accept application materials that are incomplete, do not comply with requirements or are handed in after deadline.

When applying, please take it into consideration that the receiving institutions of our exchange partners might decide on cancelling the programme owing to the actual COVID-19 pandemic situation. Therefore, even in case of a successful evaluation process, we recommend all applicants to be prepared for doing their rotations at the clinics of UP MS as an alternative option.

Assessment of applications:

The applications will be judged by the International Relations Committee. The final decision will be made by the vice-dean for education.

Students who have not previously participated in the Erasmus program will be given priority in course of evaluation. Students who are not awarded a grant but are recommended by the institute/department responsible for the cooperation can participate even in the lack of a grant as self-funded students, so called **label students**, provided they can cover the costs of their travel and stay abroad from other sources.

Double financing of costs and expenses is prohibited.
