



**INFORMATION FOR 1ST AND 2ND YEAR STUDENTS  
ON THE PCR TEST AND HEALTH APTITUDE TEST**

**Dear Student!**

**A. PCR-test for 1st and 2nd year (General Medicine) students**

We hereby inform you that the Faculty provides opportunity for taking the PCR-test for those students as well who are not obliged to take it in order to start the academic year or a practice (based on any law or university regulations), but just want to make sure of their own state of health.

Those students who are in quarantine or show symptoms at the beginning of the semester can only show up for the test at the Centre for Occupational Medicine and Work Hygiene only when their quarantine or symptoms are.
<b>Result of the PCR test</b>	<b>In case of positive result the University will get in touch with the student.</b>
<b>Mask-wearing</b>	Wearing a mask is obligatory during the test.

**Taking the PCR-test and showing the result is required only for attending the classes of subjects with patient contact or being held at clinics, it is not required for other classes!**

However, in case you experience symptoms, please do not attend your classes and call the **PTE Hotline (+36305773764) immediately** for information on what to do!

**B. Health aptitude tests**

As we informed you previously, due to epidemiological circumstances the Centre for Occupational Medicine and Work Hygiene **suspended the health aptitude tests with immediate effect and the already booked appointments are deleted until further notification.** The health aptitude tests will be carried out later depending on the epidemiological situation. The missing health aptitude test results will temporarily not cause problems in the students' study progress taking into consideration the current circumstances.
