



Procedures of our School in case of coronavirus infection or suspected infection

**Actions to be taken in case of coronavirus infection or suspected infection at the
UPMS**

1. An infected person or a person suspected of being infected shall be given a surgical or textile face mask immediately if his/her condition allows and shall be isolated immediately in a separate room, outdoors or at home. Elevators, face-to-face meetings, and public transport should be avoided as much as possible in order to minimize further contacts during the transport required for isolation.

Until isolation is achieved or the patient is transported, the others present must wear a surgical or textile face mask.

In case of confirmed or suspected infection, the Covid Protocol pursuant to Article 27 (2) of Joint Order 14/2020 of the Rector and the Chancellor (JO 14/2020) must be followed.

2. In the case of infection in a certain organizational unit, please contribute to the contact tracing in a responsible manner, to this end it is recommended for the head of the given organizational unit to compile a list of persons who have been in contact with a confirmed coronavirus-infected patient. To be able to locate contact persons effectively, the telephone number and address or place of stay must be included in the list.

(In order to facilitate the compilation of a contact list with precise contact details, it is recommended to keep a record of the telephone numbers, addresses or places of stay of all staff members, which is available to the head of the organizational unit at all times.)

Given that contact tracing is also assisted by the Baranya County Police Headquarters, a list of possible contact persons must be provided at the request of the staff of the Police Headquarters.

3. To ensure continuous work in the organizational unit, it is the responsibility of the head of the organizational unit to ensure the replacement of the absent person(s).
4. After the infected person leaves or gets transported, cleaning with an antiviral surface disinfectant must be provided.
