people. As part of the European Climate Pact, we are inviting you to hold your own "Peer Parliament" with a small circle of friends, family, neighbours or colleagues, and discuss key topics from the perspective of your everyday life.



Climate change affects us all, yet we can do something about it in many areas of our lives: from the places we live to the vehicles we use and the food that we eat. Collectively, we can make a difference.

With the European Green Deal, a roadmap to reducing greenhouse gas emissions by at least 55% by 2030, the EU is well on track to becoming the first climate-neutral continent by 2050 – but we need you on board! Tell us your ideas, opinions and wishes on how to achieve climate neutrality in Europe.

The Peer Parliaments will finish at the end of February 2022. During that time, each person can host up to three Peer Parliament debates on the topics of mobility, energy, and food/consumption. The final report will be drafted and published in Spring 2022.
