- Technical rehab




Scoliosis

Abnormal 3D curvatures of spine (frontal, sagittal, axial)

- Structural or functional
- Childhood/adolescence ages
- Prevalence 0,47-5,2 %
- Prevalence and curve severity are higher for girls
- Characterised by Cobb angles



- Cupping












Manualtherapy

Collective term, diagnostic and therapic technics which deal with examinaton and treatment of the **reversible** disabilities of the musculoskeletal system.



Functional and tissue diagnosis (not ICD diagnoses)



Contraindications:

- acute inflammation
- destructive lesions
- severe osteoporosis
- severe degenerative deformity
- vertebrobasilar insuffitienty
- ankylosis in joints
- traumatic lesions
- psychotic difficulties

Manualtherapy

- 1. Soft tissue technic
- works on fascia, muscles, nerves, etc.
- for examples Terrier, anatomy trains, Typaldos methods
- 2. Joint mobilization (ostheopathy)
- works on joints
- slow, consistent movement in special position



- works on joints
- one sudden, fast movement
